I'd like to provide two comments on the OECD Framework:

- Table 1 appears to be not conclusive. For instance, why is "Enabling policy" very relevant for "Electricity" but not relevant at all for "Water"?
- To me a weakness of the current framework is that it does not (sufficiently) take into account that an AI system can change over time in multiple important ways, e.g. w.r.t. "criticality", breadth of deployment, maturity, its users, and its capabilities (e.g., through improved or different data sets available for model building).

PS: Regarding the survey, which I didn't complete due to lack of time, some of the questions are too unspecific. For instance, one can choose "recommendation systems", but how critical the system is and what the users are depends on the domain – e.g., Amazon recommender system vs. a (hypothetical) recommender system used by politicians to decide on public investments.

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
